Please place them in a transparent or translucent bag.

Please help reduce waste volume!

- Extract any fluids
- Use food waste volume-reducing equipment. (See backside)

Plastic containers or packaging

Weekly day

Collection begins at 7:30am

Recycled into materials used for plastic products such as pallets.

Cups, packs, trays

Bottles
Place bottles in bag after removing caps

Caps

Styrofoam

Packaging film

Bags and nets

Place items in a transparent or translucent bag and put into the black netted bag at the collection site.

Avoid double bagging.
Double bagging refers to when plastic containers and packaging are placed in small plastic bags which are all put in a large plastic bag. Place **all items together loosely in a large bag** to make it easier to identify any dangerous goods or foreign objects and to facilitate recycling.

Same collection site as for non-burnable garbage and recyclables.

Collected materials will be sold or recycled into products.

Non-burnable Garbage

① Non-burnable garbage

- Spray cans** (Empty the contents and puncture the can)
- Lighters**
- Cans** (other than drink cans) Bottles with contents will not be collected
- Mercury-free batteries**
- Metal items**
- Others** *The cloth portion of umbrellas goes in **burnable garbage**

①-2: **Cords, wires**

①-3: **Pottery, glass** (small amounts)

- Cups and glasses**
- Pottery**
- Lightbulbs, light**
- Oil bottles**
- Medicine bottles**

For large amounts, bring them to the **Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site**.

② **Aluminum cans**

- **Drink cans only**
- Place in the container **without crushing**
- Bottle caps go in **non-burnable garbage**

③ **Steel cans**

④ **Brown glass bottles**

- Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in **pottery, glass**
- Broken items are also acceptable

⑤ **Clear colorless glass bottles**

Recyclables

⑥ **Other glass bottles**

- Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in **pottery, glass**
- Broken items are also acceptable

⑦ **Returnable bottles** (beer and 1sho bottles)

- Broken bottles go in **recyclable bottles** (separate by color)

⑧ **Plastic PET bottles**

- Caps go in **plastic packaging**
- Do not remove labels
- Discard after **gently crushing bottles on their side**

⑨ **Small appliances**

- Cords should be detached and **go to Cords, Wires**.
- For large size appliances that do not fit in containers bring them to **Recyclable Collection Station**

Newspapers, flyers

Cardboard

- Attached staples are acceptable

Magazines/books

Clothes

- Attached buttons and fasteners are acceptable
- Futons go in **oversized garbage**

Paper milk cartons

Other papers

- **Paper packaging** Items with ♻️ Mark
- **Paper with Metal** Files, binders, plastic wrap boxes with slide cutters, paper with staples, etc.
- **Paper with Plastic or Cellophane tape** Empty tissue boxes with plastic film, windowed envelopes, paper with sticky notes, etc.
- **Others** Plastic-coated paper, aluminum-coated paper, thermal paper, receipts, crimped postcards, and carbon paper, photos, shredded paper, fax paper, etc.

Unrecyclable Items

- Unclean paper
- Smelly paper
- Oil-soaked paper

Disposal Method

Discard by placing items in a paper bag or a transparent/translucent plastic bag

Separate by category into the blue containers at the collection site.

(Take the bag back with you.)

No more than half capacity of the blue container for each person.

Disposal guide for spray cans

Empty the contents → Puncture the can → Place into the container as non-burnable garbage

Bind with string by category, and place on a blue sheet.

As items that get wet are difficult to recycle, if it rains, wait until the next collection day or bring them to the Recyclable Collection Station.

The following items should be treated as burnable garbage

- Dirty items
- Smelly paper (boxes for washing powder, etc.)
- Items stuffed with batting or feathers (cushions, down jackets, etc.)
- Cloth specially processed with fire retardant or other chemicals (curtains, etc.)

Grass clippings, pruned branches

From June To November

1st 2nd day
3rd 4th

Between 7:30 and 8:30 AM
(Some areas are between 7:00 and 8:00 AM)

Composted, and chip processed at treatment facilities.

Grass clippings (including leaves)

- Please remove the dirt and dry out for about one day. Place them in a transparent or translucent bag which makes them visible and then bring them in.
- * Designated garbage bags (blue) can also be used.

Pruned branches

- Please bundle them together with string. They should be dried for about one day before bringing them in.
- * For items less than 15 cm in thickness and less than 100 cm in length.

Note:

- Only for residential grass clippings and pruned branches.
- They can be put into designated garbage bags and thrown out as burnable garbage, or brought to a Recyclable Collection Station.
- As bamboo, oleander, blinds, and protective-coated or painted wood are not accepted, they cannot be recycled.

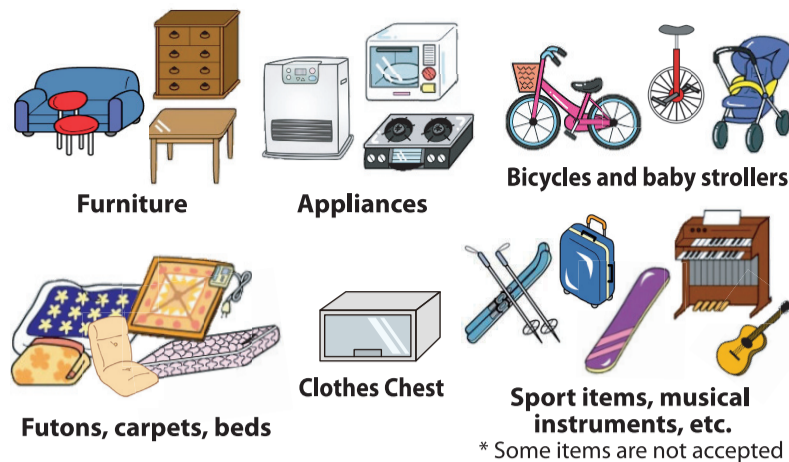

Collection when a typhoon approaches

[Burnable garbage] In principle, garbage is collected unless roads are closed, etc. In that case, collecting time may be drastically different from as usual.
[Plastic containers or packaging, Non-burnable garbage • Recyclables] Decision will be made by noon of the day before the collection day. In case of cancellation, we will inform you on the city website.

Oversized garbage Cannot be put out to collection sites



- Bring them to YUME-CLEAN (Chita Southern Wide Area Environmental Center) as mentioned below.
 - Bicycles, unicycles, household appliances, furniture (large items made of metal or wood, excluding fabric-based items) are accepted also at the Recyclable Collection Station.
- For spring mattresses, bring them to the Recyclable Collection Station.**

Garbage that cannot be disposed of by the city Cannot be put out to collection sites



Dangerous items, car parts, insulation, slates, gypsum board, syringes, etc.

Request disposal to the dealer or disposal processing vendor.

The following four major home appliances

(Clothes washers and dryers, televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers)



- Ask the appliance vendor to deal with it.
- Ask a company licensed to collect and transport the items.

- ① Buy an appliance recycling ticket at the post office.
- ② Fill out necessary items and attach to the appliance to be discarded.
- ③ Bring it to the designated collection site.

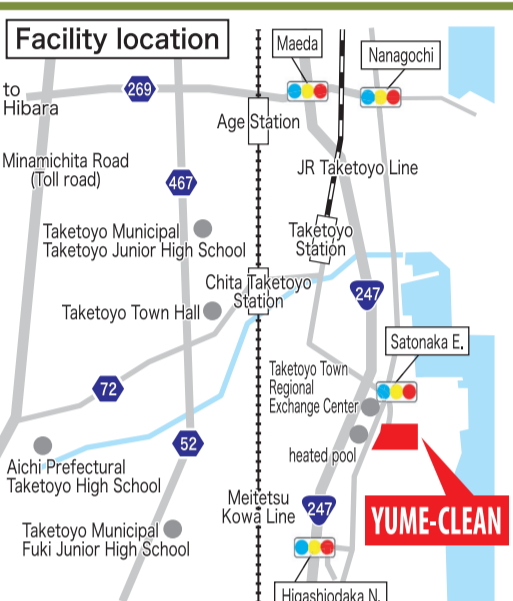

Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mondays to Fridays 8:30am to 4:15pm • Saturdays 8:30am to 1:00pm • Closed on Sundays, and New Year Holidays (from Dec.31st to Jan.3rd) <p>(Note: Dec.29th, 30th, Jan.4th, and national holidays except Sundays will open.)</p>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Drop-off charges are 100 yen for first 10 kg, and 100 yen/10 kg thereafter. * Bring items such as concrete rubble, bricks, tiles, pottery, glass, and earth and sand to the Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site. Check "garbage acceptance criteria" on YUME-CLEAN website for more information.

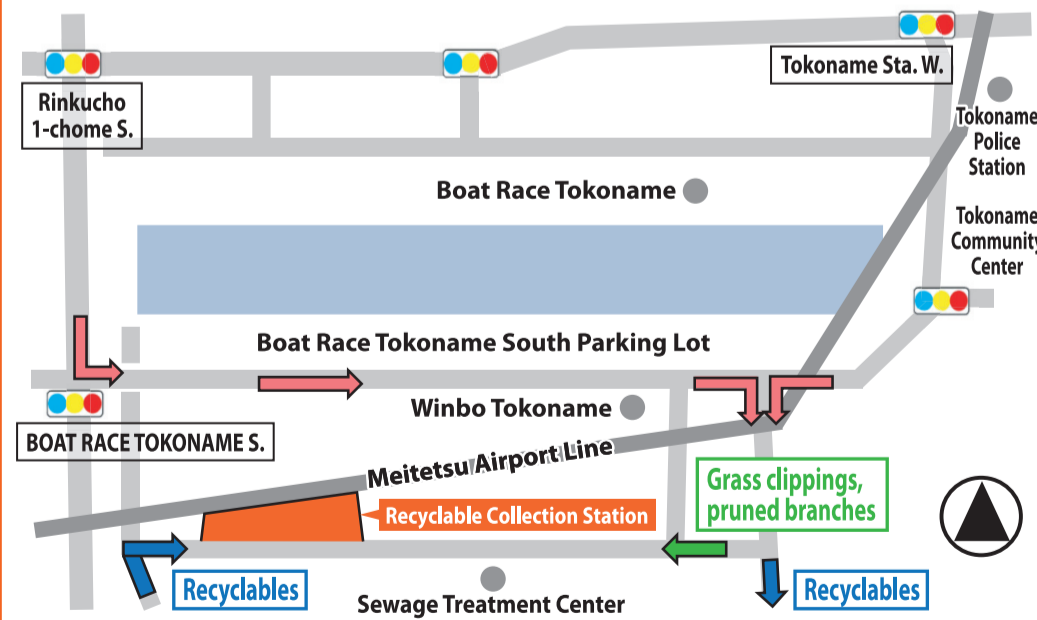
Things that can be brought in	Family-use pottery, glass, earth and sand, concrete debris, clothes-drying platforms (base only).

Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Apply to the Living Environment Division in advance and get a permission certificate. (Request can be made from 2 weeks prior to transport date) * Building materials from a building torn down by a company and industrial waste are not accepted.
