

# How to dispose of household garbage and recyclables



## Burnable garbage

Weekly

Collection begins at 7:30am

Incinerated at Clean Center Tokotake

**Kitchen scraps/Shells**

**Plastic items**

**Pet litter**

**Leather products / rubber products**  
\*Remove metal parts and put them in non-burnable garbage

**Cloth that cannot be recycled and cotton stuffing**

**Non-recyclable paper**

- Unclean paper
- Paper with strong odor e.g., detergent boxes, Incense boxes
- Used tissues

Place them in designated garbage bags.

Sold at supermarkets, convenience stores, drug stores, etc.

- **Fee exemption system**
- <Target> Disposable diapers (baby- and adult-type)
- <Disposal Method> These can be placed in a transparent or translucent bag.
- \* Pet items not permitted

**Please help reduce waste volume!**

- Extract any fluids
- Use food waste volume-reducing equipment. (See backside)

\* Commercial waste from shops, restaurants, businesses, etc. cannot be put out to collection site.

## Plastic containers or packaging

Collection begins at 7:30am

Recycled into materials used for plastic products such as pallets.

**Cups, packs, trays**

**Bottles**  
Place bottles in bag after removing caps

**Caps**

**Styrofoam**

**Plastic wrap and film**

**Bags and nets**

**\*Plastic items with unremovable stains and other plastic products go in burnable garbage**

Place items in a transparent or translucent bag and put into the black netted bag at the collection site.

**Avoid double bagging.**

Double bagging refers to when plastic containers and packaging are placed in small plastic bags which are all put in a large plastic bag. Place **all items together loosely in a large bag** to make it easier to identify any dangerous goods or foreign objects and to facilitate recycling.

**Be sure to use a black net to ensure the bags do not blow away in the wind.**

Between 7:30 and 8:30 AM (some areas are between 7:00 and 8:00 AM)

Collected materials will be sold or recycled into products. Part of the money from sales is allocated to the district.

Non-burnable Garbage

① Non-burnable garbage

- Lighters, Spray cans, Small appliances, Cans (other than drink cans), Metal, Mercury-free batteries, Other (Umbrella fabric goes in burnable garbage)

①-2: Cords, wires

①-3 Pottery, glass (small amounts)

- Cups and glasses, Pottery, Light bulbs, Medicine bottles, Oil bottles

For large amounts, bring them to the **Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site**.

② Aluminum cans

- Drink cans only
- Place in container without crushing
- Bottle caps go in non-burnable garbage

③ Steel cans

④ Brown glass bottles

- Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in pottery, glass
- Broken items are also acceptable

⑤ Clear colorless glass bottles

Recyclables

⑥ Other glass bottles

- Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in pottery, glass
- Broken items are also acceptable

⑦ Returnable bottles (beer and spirit bottles)

- Broken bottles go in recyclable bottles (separate by color)

⑧ Plastic PET bottles

- Caps go in plastic containers and packaging
- Do not remove labels
- Discard after gently crushing bottles on their side

Newspapers, flyers

Cardboard

Attached staples are acceptable

Magazines/books

Cloth

Attached buttons and fasteners are acceptable

Dispose of futons as oversized garbage

Paper milk cartons

Other papers

Discard by placing items in a paper bag or transparent/translucent plastic bag

Separate by category into the blue containers at the collection site.

(Take the bag back with you.)

**Size and volume should be small enough to hold in one hand.**

**Bottles with contents will not be collected**

Empty all contents before discarding

**Bundle with string by category, and place on a blue sheet.**

As items that get wet are difficult to recycle, if it's raining, wait until the next collection day or use a **Recyclable Collection Station**.

The following items should go in **burnable garbage**

- Non-recyclable paper (soiled paper, paper with strong odor, used tissues, etc.)
- Things stuffed with batting or feathers (cushions, down jackets, etc.)
- Cloth treated with fire retardant or other chemicals (curtains, etc.)
- Leather goods (leather jackets, etc.)

## Grass clippings, pruned branches

Between 7:30 and 8:30 AM (some areas are between 7:00 and 8:00 AM)

Processed as chips at processing facility.

**Grass clippings (including leaves)**

- Discard by shaking off dirt and placing items in a **transparent or translucent plastic bag**.
- \* Designated garbage bags (blue) can also be used.

**Pruned branches**

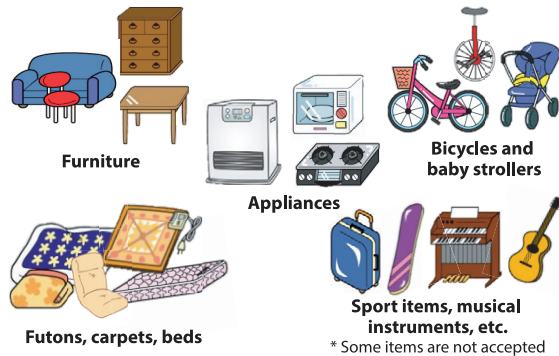
- Throw out **after bundling together with string** so as not to fall apart.
- \* Length should no more than 1 m.

**Note:**

- Only for residential grass clippings and pruned branches.
- Same collection site as for burnable garbage and recyclables.
- As in the past, you can place such in the designated garbage bag and discarded as burnable garbage, but to promote recycling please use local collection sites and the **Recyclable Collection Station**.
- Blinds and protective-coated or painted wood are not accepted as they cannot be recycled.

## Oversized garbage Cannot be put out to collection site



- Bring them to Clean Center Tokotake.
- Household appliances, furniture (large items made of metal or wood, excluding fabric-based items), and bicycles are accepted also at the Recyclable Collection Station.

Things that can be brought in	Burnable garbage, non-burnable garbage and oversized garbage.
Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monday to Friday 8:30 to 11:30am, 1:00 to 4:00pm</li> <li>• Saturday 8:30 to 11:30am (closed on the third Saturday of the month, Sundays, and New Year Holidays)</li> </ul>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Drop-off charges are 100 yen for first 10 kg, and 100 yen/10 kg thereafter (effective as of April 1, 2018)</li> <li>* Bring items such as concrete rubble, bricks, tiles, pottery, glass, and dirt to a Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site.</li> </ul>

## Garbage that is not collected by the city Cannot be put out to collection site



Dangerous items, car parts, insulation, slate, gypsum board, syringe, agricultural chemical, etc.

**Request disposal to the dealer or disposal processing vendor.**

### The following four major home appliances

(Clothes washers and dryers, televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers)

- Ask the appliance vendor to deal with it.
- Ask a company licensed to collect and transport the items.
  - ① Buy an appliance recycling ticket at the post office.
  - ② Fill out necessary items and attach to the appliance to be discarded.
  - ③ Bring it to the designated collection area.

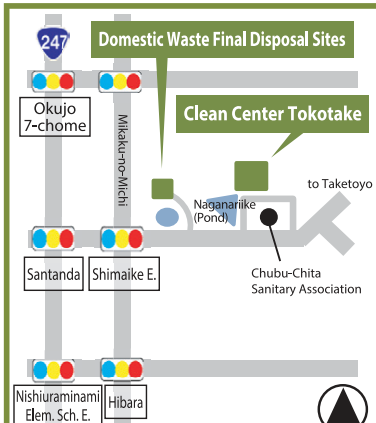

 • One ton per person/two truckloads per day

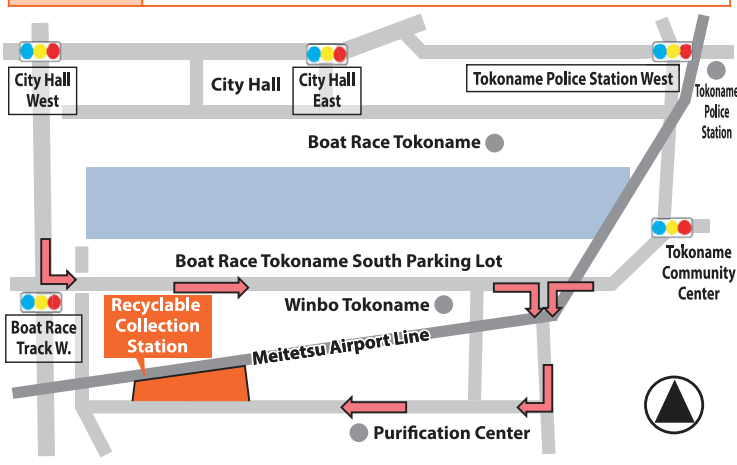
Things that can be brought in	Household pottery, glass, dirt, concrete debris, clothes-drying platforms (without bars)
Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wednesday and Saturday 9:00 to 11:30am, 1:00 to 3:30pm</li> <li>(closed on national holidays and during New Year Holidays)</li> </ul>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Apply to the Living Environment Division in advance and get a permission certificate. (Request can be made from 2 weeks prior to transport date)</li> <li>* Building materials from a building torn down by a company and industrial waste are not accepted.</li> </ul>



## Recyclable Collection Station

Things that can be brought in	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recyclables • Non-burnable garbage • Pottery, glass (small amounts only) • Plastic containers and packaging</li> <li>• Oversized garbage (metal/wood) • Personal computers</li> <li>• Household appliances (excluding fabric-based appliances and the four designated home appliances) • Cooking oil • Engine oil • Batteries</li> <li>• Grass clippings, pruned branches (Charges effective as of April 1, 2018)</li> </ul>
Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fri, Sat, Sun, Mon, Tue/8:30 - 11:30am</li> <li>(closed during New Year Holidays)</li> </ul>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Follow staff instructions.</li> <li>* Separate items correctly.</li> <li>* Non-acceptable items (burnable garbage, metals, oversized garbage other than wood products, fabric-based appliances, and the four designated home appliances) cannot be dropped off.</li> </ul>

## Small-appliance collection box Help recycle small appliances.

Collection boxes have been installed in order to recycle precious and rare metals contained in small appliances

**Small appliances that fit in 35 cm x 8 cm collection boxes are eligible.**  
 \* Erase data, etc., beforehand to prevent disclosure of personal information.

## Florescent light collection box Be sure to handle mercury properly.

A collection box is available for the proper handling of mercury.

**Items that can be collected:**  
 Florescent lights (tube type • bulb type • ring type)

\* Do not place anything other than florescent lights (incandescent light bulbs or LED products) and do not place broken florescent lights.
