How to dispose of household garbage and recyclables

* Commercial waste from shops, restaurants, businesses, etc. cannot be put out to collection sites.

Please do not put out garbage outside of the designated times, such as the day before collection.

The collected resources will be recycled into new products. PET bottles are reborn as PET bottles.

Non-burnable Garbage

Non-burnable garbage

- Lighters (Empty the gas)
- Spray cans (Empty the contents and puncture the can)
- Others: *The cloth portion of umbrellas goes in burnables
- Cans (other than drink cans) Bottles with contents will not be collected
- Metal items
- Cords, wires
- Pottery, glass (small amounts): Cups and glasses, Pottery, Lightbulbs, light
- Oil bottles, Medicine bottles

For large amounts, bring them to the Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site.

Separate by category into the blue containers at the collection site. (Take the bag back with you.)
No more than half capacity of the blue container for each person.

Disposal guide for spray cans: Empty the contents → Puncture the can → Place into the container as non-burnable garbage

Bind with string by category, and place on a blue sheet.

As items that get wet are difficult to recycle, if it rains, wait until the next collection day or bring them to the Recyclable Collection Station.

The following items should be treated as **Burnables**:

- Dirty items
- Unrecyclable paper (laundry detergent boxes, etc.)
- Items stuffed with batting or feathers (Cushions, down jackets, mattress pads, etc)
- Cloth specially processed with fire retardant or other chemicals (curtains, etc.)

Recyclables

Aluminum cans: Drink cans only. Place in the container without crushing. Bottle caps go in non-burnable garbage.

Steel cans: (Steel recycling symbol)

Brown glass bottles: Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in pottery, glass. Broken items are also acceptable.

Clear colorless glass bottles:

Other glass bottles: Bottles with oil or chemical residue go in pottery, glass. Broken items are also acceptable.

Returnable bottles: (beer and 1sho bottles). Broken bottles go in recyclable bottles (separate by color).

Plastic PET bottles: Caps go in plastic packaging. Do not remove labels. Discard after gently crushing bottles on their side.

Small appliances: Cords should be detached and go to Cords, Wires. For large size appliances that do not fit in containers, bring them to Recyclable Collection Station.

Batteries: Please insulate both electrode parts with cellophane tape. Lithium-ion, mobile, and button batteries can also be put out.

Paper milk cartons, Newspapers, flyers, Cardboard, Magazines/books, Clothes: Attached buttons and fasteners are acceptable. Blankets and Futons go in oversized garbage.

Other paper types: Paper containers and packaging items coated with plastic, paper cartons with aluminum, paper cups, thermal paper, shopping receipts, carbon paper, window envelopes, business cards, photographs, tickets, notebooks, packaging materials, origami paper, product tags.

It is acceptable for items to have staples, paper clips, cellophane tape, coatings, or binding string attached.

Unrecyclable Items: Laminated items, Paper with calligraphy or paint on it, Dirty paper, Smelly paper, Oil-soaked paper.

Disposal Method: Discard by placing items in a paper bag or in a transparent/translucent plastic bag.

Plastic containers or packaging Weekly

Collection begins at 7:30 AM

Recycled into materials used for plastic products such as pallets.

Place items in a transparent or translucent bag and put into the black netted bag at the collection site.

Avoid double bagging. Double bagging means a large bag contains small bags placed with plastic containers and packaging. Place all items together loosely in a large bag to make it easier to identify any dangerous goods or foreign objects and to facilitate recycling.

Same collection site as for recyclables and non-burnable garbage.

***Plastic items with unremovable stains and other plastic products go in Burnables**

Incinerated at YUME-CLEAN (Chita Southern Wide Area Environmental Center)

Place them in designated garbage bags. Sold at supermarkets, convenience stores, drug stores, etc.

Disposable diapers for babies and adults can be placed for free.

<Disposal Method> Please place them in a transparent or translucent bag.

Please cooperate with us to **reduce waste volume!**

- drain any liquid
- Use food waste volume-reducing equipment. (See backside)

Grass clippings, pruned branches

Between 7:30 and 8:30 AM (Some areas are between 7:00 and 8:00 AM)

Composted, and chip processed at treatment facilities.

Grass clippings (including leaves): Please remove the dirt and dry out for about one day. Place them in a transparent or translucent bag which makes them visible and then bring them in.

Pruned branches: Dry for about a day, then tie with string before putting out. * Applicable only for branches under 100cm long and 15 cm in diameter.

Note:

- Only for residential grass clippings and pruned branches.
- Same collection site as for recyclables and non-burnable garbage.
- They can be put into designated garbage bags and thrown out as burnable garbage, or brought to a Recyclable Collection Station.
- As bamboo, oleander, blinds, vegetable scraps and protective-coated or painted wood are not recycled, they cannot be accepted.

Collection when a typhoon is approaching, snow is forecast, or snow has accumulated

[Burnables] In principle, garbage is collected unless roads are closed, etc. In that case, collecting time may be drastically different from as usual. Decision will be made by noon of the day before the collection day. In case of cancellation, we will inform you on the city website.

Oversized garbage Cannot be put out to collection sites



- Bring them to YUME-CLEAN (Chita Southern Wide Area Environmental Center).
- Some items are also accepted at the Recyclable Collection Station. For details, please check the section "Recyclable Collection Station".
- **For spring mattresses, bring them to the Recyclable Collection Station.**

Garbage that cannot be collected by the city Cannot be put out to collection sites



Dangerous items, car parts, slates, gypsum board, syringes, etc.

Request disposal to the dealer or disposal processing vendor.

The following four major home appliances
(Clothes washers and dryers, televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers)

* For inquiries regarding home appliance recycling, please contact the Home Appliance Recycling Call Center at 0120-319640.

- **Ask the appliance vendor to deal with it.**
- **Ask a company licensed to collect and transport the items.**

- ① Buy an appliance recycling ticket at the post office.
- ② Fill out necessary items and attach to the appliance to be discarded.
- ③ Bring it to the designated collection site.

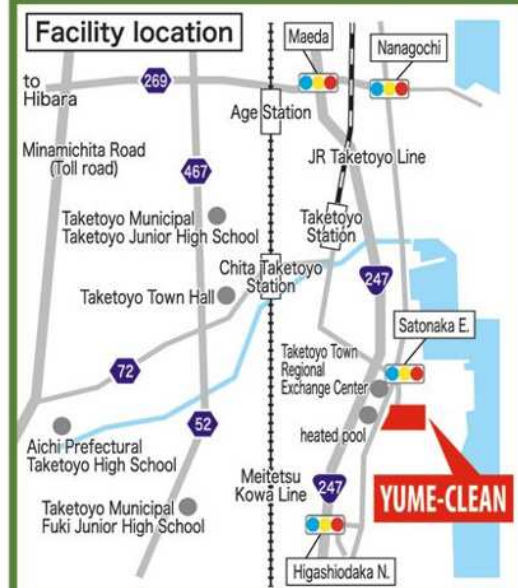

Things that can be brought in	Burnable garbage, non-burnable garbage, and oversized garbage.
Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mondays to Fridays 8:30am to 4:15pm • Saturdays 8:30am to 1:00pm • Closed on Sundays, and New Year Holidays (from Dec.31st to Jan.3rd) <p>(Note: Dec.29th, 30th, Jan.4th, and national holidays except Sundays will open.)</p>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Drop-off charges are 100 yen for first 10 kg, and 100 yen/10 kg thereafter. * Bring items such as concrete rubble, bricks, tiles, pottery, glass, and earth and sand to the Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site. Check "garbage acceptance criteria" on YUME-CLEAN website for more information.



Domestic Waste Final Disposal Site Permission is required.

Location: Okudaira, Tarumi, Tokoname City • One ton per person/two truckloads per day
Acceptance of waste may be temporarily suspended during typhoons or heavy snowfall.

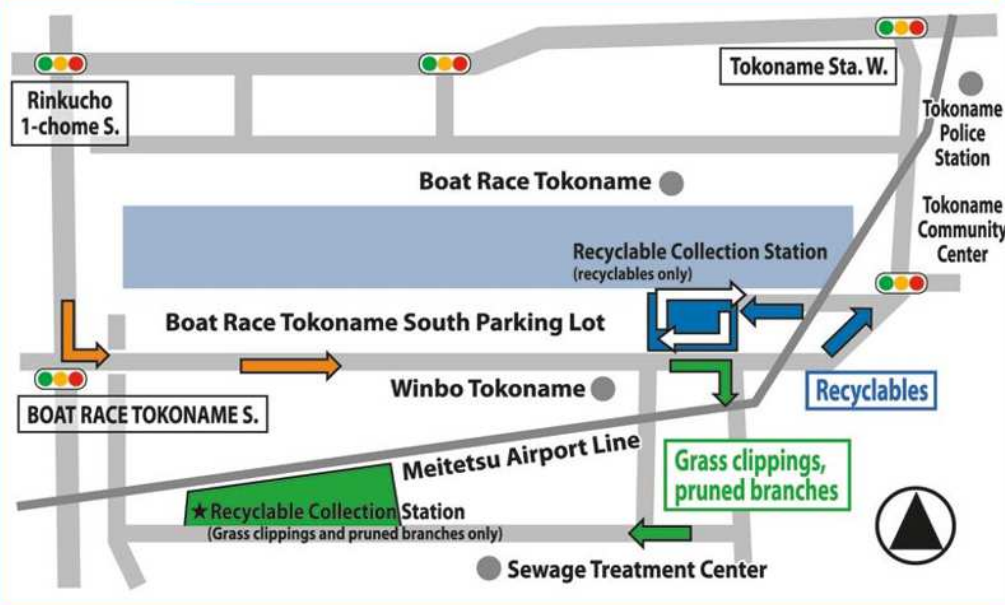
Things that can be brought in	Family-use pottery, glass, earth and sand, concrete debris, clothes-drying platforms (base only).
Reception Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wednesdays and Saturdays 9:00am to 11:30am • 1:00pm to 3:30pm <p>(Closed on national holidays and during New Year Holidays)</p>
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Apply to the Living Environment Division in advance and get a permission certificate. (Request can be made from 2 weeks prior to the carry-in date) * Building materials from demolition by a company and industrial waste are not accepted. * Items containing mercury or other hazardous substances cannot be accepted.

Recyclable Collection Station Free of charge

Only recyclables brought from households are accepted.
Acceptance of waste may be temporarily suspended during typhoons or heavy snowfall.

Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Please remove any soil and make sure to dry the grass clippings and pruned branches before putting them out. If your truck's cargo bed has wooden boards or some other type of enclosure, your load will not be accepted. Logs and branches can be up to 1 m in length and up to 15 cm in thickness. * If a disposal worker deems your load to be unacceptable, you will have to take it back.
Instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Please sort items in advance. * Follow the instructions given by disposal workers. * To reduce congestion around Tokoname Community Center, please come from the direction of the Boat Race Tokoname South intersection.

Subsidies are available for those who purchase a new food waste reduction device.

Collection Sites for Used Cooking Oil (Waste Cooking Oil)

Household waste cooking oil can be discarded at the following locations.

Disposal method	Place the bottle containing waste cooking oil into the box during facility operating hours. * Containers other than the dedicated bottles are also acceptable.
Disposal locations	Tokoname City Hall, Seikai Community Center, Nanryo Community Center, Tokoname Citizens Community, Tokoname Gymnasium, Recyclable collection stations * Empty bottles are also available at the collection points.
